**Job description**

We are looking to appoint a dynamic and enthusiastic individual to lead, develop and manage a team of four Science Technicians to support all aspects of a large and successful Science Department. Relevant experience of working in a school laboratory is desirable (although training can be provided in this aspect of the role) however experience of managing a team is essential.

The Science Department is a high achieving department, furthering learning through practical science, and has 19 teaching staff and five technicians, three full-time and two part-time. Between them they cover Science lessons for students from Year 7 to Sixth Form. At GCSE level students study for Core, Additional and Triple Science, as well as BTEC Science, and at A Level Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Applied Science are offered. Many students at Backwell choose to study Science subjects in the Sixth Form, and in 2015 there were over 100 entries at A2 level with 37% of those achieving an A or A\* grade. At GCSE level 86% of students gained at least two passes in Science at grade C or above.

We are looking for someone with good scientific skills and proven management experience, but above all we want an enthusiastic, hard-working team leader, who is able to release the potential of all team members.
